St. Michael Catholic School will offer partial scholarships to cover the cost of tuition for the upcoming school year of 2018-2019 provided a family qualifies for the tuition assistance being offered. A family may request full scholarship; however, the pastor has the authority to grant a partial or full scholarship based on financial need.

**All applications are due in the school office on May 1, 2018 by 3:00 p.m.**

Applications will be reviewed by the scholarship committee which consists of the pastor, principal, and school advisory board finance chairperson. **All applications are strictly confidential.** Scholarship recipients will be notified by June 7, 2018.

If you would like to apply for this opportunity, please read carefully the information below, sign, date, and complete the attached application providing all required information. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. If you have any questions, you may contact the school office (979) 725-8461.

If my family is awarded a scholarship for tuition assistance to St. Michael Catholic School, I understand that I will be expected to adhere to the following:

1. Be an active participant in the St. Michael Parish spring picnic that benefits St. Michael Catholic School, held the last Sunday in April.\*
2. Be an active participant in the St. Michael Catholic School Home and School Association Point System by working fundraising events and selling fundraising items in order to earn the required points for my family.\*
3. Pay the family portion of the tuition balance by the 18<sup>th</sup> of each month beginning in August and ending in May.

\* If a parent is disabled, a community or other family member may work in place of the parent.

In addition, I understand that my child/children will be expected to adhere to the following:

1. Follow the mission of St. Michael Catholic School which calls us to “be friendly, respectful, responsible, and Christ-like”.
2. Maintain appropriate and expected behavior, receiving no disciplinary infractions for serious behavioral offenses as outlined in the student handbook.
3. Maintain an overall GPA of 80 or above during the school year in which the scholarship was granted.

Scholarships are awarded based on financial need, year-to-year, and are not automatically renewed. Families must reapply each spring.
