- **Because you asked: How much do utilities for the school cost?** The monthly budget to keep the lights on, the AC running, and the water flowing is \$22,763.00. This estimated amount is based on the 2017-2018 budget figures. The actual amount will be adjusted with the October 1 revised budget. We have 91 students enrolled. The total monthly tuition coming in for 91 students is expected to be \$25,615.00. As you can see, monthly tuition, if paid on time, can cover the cost of utilities, but what about salaries, teaching supplies, internet service, contracts with textbook companies computer programs, and such?
