- **Private Schools Interscholastic Meet (PSIA) Saturday, February 16 at Our Lady of Victory Catholic School in Victoria 1311 East Mesquite Lane:** The first event begins promptly at 8:00 a.m. All workers and students must be on time to EVERY event so as not to delay the contest. Workers must read all instructions for their assignments and ask questions when unsure of what to do. Please be sure students have whatever supplies are needed for their events: paper and pencils, blue pens for number sense, dictionary for dictionary skills, documentation for prose and the prose piece, etc. Remind students taking objective tests to use capital letters for their answers, and students in ready writing may not write on the back of their papers. Students in speech and writing competitions are also not allowed to use their name or school name in the speech or essay. Refer to the information for your event to be sure all rules are followed.
