Working Points:

- Each family will need to earn 6 working points in the Fall and 5 working points in the Spring.
- For any working points not earned, families will need to pay \$118.15/point not earned.
- If your shift occurs during an event, that requires a ticket or fee/admission for entry. You will need to purchase a ticket before working the event.
- To receive or donate points, you need to clearly print the family name you are working for on the sign-in sheet at the event.
- If you sign up for a shift and do not fulfill or find a replacement, you will be charged \$100 for that shift.

Selling Points:

- Each family will need to raise \$650 in the Fall and \$550 in the Spring.
- Selling point value amounts are noted in each of the graphs above for each fundraiser.

Fundraising Event Descriptions:

- Dubina Picnic - This is a Parish Picnic where we receive profit in exchange for workers.
- Little Caesars Pizza & Otis Spunkmeyer Cookie Dough - These fundraisers will be combined for a fundraising option for families in the fall.
- Strudels & Gourmet Cookies - This fundraiser is an option to meet your fall goal.
- Night on the Town (NOTT) - This event is an annual SMCS tradition with appetizers, dinner, open bar, and dance. Profit is made through the silent auction and ticket sales. The more people we have in attendance, the greater profit potential.
- Catholic Life Sweepstakes - Greatest profit percentage with no expenses. All profit goes to SMCS. Ask for opportunities to sell at MG, Hill Bank, other businesses, and after Mass. Our 2020 profit=\$13,000.
- Jingle Fest - SMCS hosts a 5K run/walk. It will finish with a *Breakfast with Santa*, fun kids activities, and vendor booths.
- Drive Thru Meal - This is an event to celebrate and kick off Catholic Schools Week. This event is considered a service project by the families of SMCS, so no working points are offered. Selling points will be offered as an opportunity to meet your spring goal.
- Rolls by Mrs. Daria Emmel - This fundraiser is an opportunity to meet your spring goal.
- Track Meet - Our profit from this event ranges from \$4,000-\$6,000 with the blessing of cooperating weather. This event requires the greatest number of workers. It has always received outstanding publicity from other schools as we serve the children in our diocese and area. You must pay the admission fee.
- Crawfish Boil - This event is an important fundraiser for the Spring. It offers appetizers, crawfish and sides, and also includes an alternative meal with an open bar and silent auction.
- Wino-de-Mayo Wine Bingo - This was a new and successful event in 2019. It includes bingo with wine or beer prizes, door prizes, and nacho bar.
