- **Attendance:** Please recall that attendance is demonstrated through communication with the teacher when requested and work turned in to the teacher. Students are asked to follow the schedule outlined for them to receive the full benefit of the SMCS distance education program and to avoid an absence or missing instruction that would benefit the student on later assignments or assessments.
