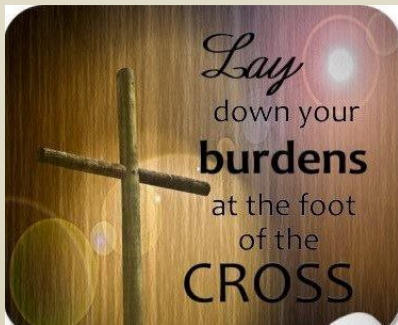

- **Holy Thursday and Easter Break Schedule:** EC and Elementary students will have a Google Meet with their teachers according to the schedule the teacher provides. All junior high teachers will attend a Google Meet with their homeroom teacher (8th with Mrs. McAfee) at 11:00 a.m. tomorrow. Junior high students will be praying the Stations of the Cross as a class using the presentation provided by the teacher. Students will have no other classes or assignments on Thursday and throughout the remainder of Holy Week and into Easter. We will resume classes via distance education on Tuesday, April 14.

Easter Sunday, All Day, There will be no live streamed Mass – you may watch the recorded Easter Vigil Mass from Saturday evening.
- **Morning Prayer with Mrs. McAfee:** There will be no Monday Morning Meet due to the Easter holiday. **Mrs. McAfee will host a Google Meet on Thursday, April 16, at 8:00 a.m.** for our traditional Morning Prayer and announcements – birthdays included. The link to join will be sent via email with a parent alert reminder shortly before the meeting begins. Please remember to mute your mics after greeting others or if entering late and prayers have begun.
- **Distance Education Attendance Update:** Attendance is demonstrated through communication via Google Meet, email, or text messaging with the student’s teacher(s) and turning in all assigned work that is due for grading. The teacher may send an absence notification to remind you to check in and/or return work. Any absences the teacher marks that are not removed will be reported to Mrs. McAfee for consideration. We understand that not all of our students may be able to access technology for a Meet or complete work by the assigned time, particularly our youngest students in early childhood and elementary whose parents are working full-time, relying on others to help care for their children. We are here to help you, so please do not hesitate to call, email, or text your child’s teacher if you are unable to get work turned in when requested or would like the teacher to schedule a one-to-one session with your child.
- **Early Registration for 2020-2021 Extended:** Thank you for getting your 2020-2021 registration packets and fees turned in to the office. Mrs. Barcak, our new secretary, will be in the office on Wednesday, April 15, from 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. if you would like to stop by to drop off your registration and payment.
- **Cafeteria Payments:** Mrs. Rubio sent out statements today requesting payment from those families who did not pay for March lunches – this payment was due March 2. If you have a credit, you may email Mrs. Rubio letting her know if you would like a refund or would like her to roll over remaining funds to May and/or 2020-2021.
