St. Michael Catholic School will award a limited number of financial aid scholarships for the 2022-2023 school year. Scholarships are available as tuition assistance for families with identified financial need. The funds are reserved for tuition and capital fees only and do not include after school care or incidental charges.

All applications are due in the school office by May 5, 2022 by 3:30 p.m.

All applications are strictly confidential. Scholarship recipients will be notified by the end of May.

If you would like to apply for this opportunity, please read carefully the information below, sign, date, and complete the attached application providing all required information. **Incomplete applications will not be considered for funding.** If you have any questions, you may contact the school office (979) 725-8461 or Rev. If my child is awarded a scholarship for tuition assistance to St. Michael Catholic School, I/we, the parent(s)/guardian(s) understand that we will be expected to adhere to the following:

1. Follow the mission of St. Michael Catholic School which calls us to “be friendly, respectful, responsible, and Christ-like.”
2. Participate in the St. Michael Catholic School Home and School Association Point System to the best of our ability by working events and selling fundraising items as required.
3. Pay the family portion of the tuition balance by the due date beginning in August and ending in May.

In addition, I understand that my child/children will be expected to adhere to the following:

1. Follow the mission of St. Michael Catholic School which calls us to “be friendly, respectful, responsible, and Christ-like.”
2. Maintain appropriate and expected behavior, receiving no disciplinary infractions for serious behavioral offenses as outlined in the student handbook.
3. Maintain a grade average of 70 or above for all core areas: religion, ELAR (average of reading, English, and spelling), math, history, and science each quarter grades are reported during the school year the scholarship was awarded.

Failure of parent/guardian and/or child (children) to adhere to any/all of the above expectations may result in the loss of scholarship and/or withdrawal from St. Michael Catholic School.

Scholarships are awarded based on financial need, year-to-year, and are not automatically renewed. Families must reapply each spring for the new school year.
