Iowa Assessment

Students in first through eighth grade will be taking the Iowa Assessment of Basic Skills standardized test next week, beginning Monday, September 19th. Testing will take place every day from 8:15 until 10:15. Areas of testing include Word Analysis (Phonics), Reading Comprehension, Written Expression (Grammar), Vocabulary, Math, Computation, Listening, Science, and Social Studies. Not all grade levels take each of these tests. Some grades will be finished by Thursday, but there are a few that will go into Friday. Grades 2 and 6 will also take the CogAt test which measures intellectual abilities and will show the students' most successful way of learning.

To help your child do well on the test: (1) Make sure he or she gets a good night's sleep and eats a healthy breakfast (not just sugary snacks.) There should be no homework or subject area tests next week until Friday. (2) Be sure your child has what he or she needs for the test, #2 pencils and a white eraser. Teachers also have items available in the classroom. (3) Remain positive. Staying calm will help your child stay calm. If he or she gets nervous about the test or is likely to experience anxiety during the test, help him or her practice some relaxation techniques that he or she can try during the test.

Please be sure your child does not have any morning appointments next week. If your child is sick, please notify the office right away so we know not to wait for him or her. The tests will need to be made up once he or she returns to school.
