All students in grades 1 – 8 are required to perform a minimum number of hours of community service, hours equivalent to the grade the student is enrolled. Example: Sam B. is enrolled in second grade, so she will perform a minimum of 2 hours of community service. Students in grade 8 must perform a minimum of 15 hours of service. Service hours must be turned in on time with all minimum requirements met in order to receive the Service Award in May.

Examples of service include but are not limited to the following:

Mowing an elderly person's yard or assisting an elderly person with yard/household chores with no payment involved; helping with local food drives and making baskets of food for community drives; caring for animals when a neighbor or relative is out of town; personal babysitting where no payment is involved; visiting a nursing home or assisted living facility outside of the school day; assisting with church/school office tasks, festivals, and picnics. Do not include altar serving on this form for weekend or school service – only include when you serve for a funeral and do not get paid. Other services should be approved by the Principal.
